THE BEGINNING

The AXTRACK was developed as a multi-purpose all terrain vehicle to deal effectively with the Alpine conditions of South Eastern Australia.

This region of Australia presents demanding challenges for any general utility vehicle.

In the Winter, flooding and snow on the Alpine heights create wild and rugged conditions which are seldom encountered in North America and Europe.

Emergency services, such as firefighting, and search and rescue operations can become dangerous, and Winter patrols of pipelines, and the maintenance of power supply and communications are extremely difficult to sustain.

In the Summer, many areas are inaccessible for routine forestry control and general emergency services because of large national forests and the limited number of all-weather roads.

The development of Axtrack, initially as an oversnow utility vehicle, began at Falls Creek, a major ski resort in Victoria, over fifteen years ago.

Since that time, innovative design and engineering and thorough field testing has led to the patent of a unique steering clutch assembly. The application of this development has resulted in the production of AXTRACK, a general multi-purpose, all terrain vehicle for international use.
